

## Submission Details

- The original unpublished research papers, articles, review papers, practice-oriented papers, and case studies having maximum length 5 pages on the topics related to the theme are invited for presentation/publication as a book chapter in the conference proceedings.
- Kindly ensure that your paper is formatted as per Taylor & Francis template. Please refer the attached template for preparation of your paper.
- All papers must be submitted online via Microsoft CMT submission portal using the following link: (<https://cmt3.research.microsoft.com/SMSI2025>)
- All submissions will be thoroughly peer-reviewed by experts based on originality, significance and clarity.
- Only papers presenting original content with novel research results or successful innovative applications will be considered for publication in the conference proceedings (as chapters in edited volumes of Taylor & Francis series)

## Plagiarism Policy

The paper prior to submission should be checked for plagiarism from licensed plagiarism software like Turnitin. The similarity index should be less than 10% in any case either self-content (max 3%). Further, you have to strictly implement the following ethical guidelines for publication:

- Any form of self-plagiarism or plagiarism from others' work(s) should not be there in an article.
- If any model / concept / figure / table / data / conclusive comment by any previously published work is used in your article, you should properly cite a reference to the original work.
- Also, language of explaining it should not be same as language of the work from which you have adopted it. If you are using any copyrighted material, you should acquire prior permission from the copyright holder.

## Publication

- Please note that all accepted, presented, registered and peer-reviewed paper will be published as book chapter in Taylor & Francis (Scopus Indexed).

## Manuscript preparation details (in brief)

The full paper length in the prescribed format should not be more than 5 pages. Figures should be clearly visible (at least 300 dpi).

Submit the manuscript in Microsoft Word format.
